

Route 5: **Tunis**

(second and third entrance to Tunis from Lake Qarun and second entrance to Tunis from Ibshaway Street)

GPS INFORMATION	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION	PHOTO
E 030°28.526' N 29°24.622'	The distance between the first entrance and the second entrance to Tunis from the main road on Lake Qarun is around 700m. The second entrance is marked by 3 signs giving directions for Tunis Village and Qasr Qarun, Hotel Palm Shadow Corner (Zilal Al Nakhil) and the Pottery School.	

GPS INFORMATION	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION	PHOTO
E 030°28.491' N 29°24.644'	The third entrance to Tunis is marked by a blue sign written on it in Arabic “Medinet Yousef Al Seddik”. The roads after the second and third entrance to Tunis run parallel and lead to the same crossroads.	
E 030°28.497' N 29°24.174'	After around 800m, you will pass by a petrol station and reach a crossroads with small supermarkets and coffee shops; on the crossroads, turn left to go to Tunis, turn right to go to Qarun or straight to go to Wadi El Rayyan. 92 at petrol station is available.

E030°29.635 N 29°23.604	At the crossroads, go left into Ibshaway Street to go to Tunis all the way straight for around 1.5km until you reach the second entrance to Tunis; the second entrance is marked by two signs “Tounes Pottery Welcom” and “Hotel Sobek”.	
E 030°29.658' N 29°23.703'	After some meters, you will find Abdel Sattar's Pottery on the left. The first street right after Abdel Sattar's Pottery to the left will take you straight to the main road inside Tunis.	

GPS INFORMATION	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION	PHOTO
E 030°29.733' N 29°23.767'	Or take the second entrance to Tunis from Ibshaway Street to pass by Abdel Sattar's Pottery, continue straight until the end of the street; then turn right and you will arrive at Hotel Sobek.	
E 030°29.743' N 29°23.759'	Right after Hotel Sobek, you will reach the pottery workshop of Ibrahim Samir.	

GPS INFORMATION	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION	PHOTO
E 030°29.782' N 29°23.737'	A few meters after pottery Ibrahim Samir, you will reach Evelyn's Pottery School.
